ABOUT FRONTIER

Frontier Nursing University is the oldest continually operated nurse-midwifery program in the US. They opened the first family nurse practitioner certificate program in the country, and, in 1989, pioneered the first midwifery community-based distance education program in the US.

THE CHALLENGE

- Frontier University needed a way to drive innovation in their programs without overloading faculty and staff.
- They sought to develop a common language around curriculum and program design.
- Frontier needed a tool that fostered collaboration even when teams couldn't be in the same room together.
- Ultimately, they needed a way to design a scalable process to help them align their curriculum and create a smoother pathway toward accreditation.

HOW COURSETUNE HELPED

- Courstune helped Frontier get curriculum information out of complex spreadsheets and into a visual format with common terminology
- Faculty and staff could see gaps in their curriculum for the first time.
- Coursetune's collaboration tools helped Frontier to work together on programs even when they couldn't be in the same room together.
- The Coursetune intentional design made it easier for Frontier to develop a streamlined design process that doesn't overburden faculty.
